### Tender Information Document in respect of a tender offer for outstanding Senior Unsecured Floating Rate and PIK Interest Green Notes with ISIN SE0016101810

Ilija Batljan Invest AB (publ), reg. no. 559053-5166 (the "**Issuer**") today announces its invitation to the holders (including any beneficial owners who hold their Notes (as defined below) via nominees or custodians) (the "**Noteholders**" and each a "**Noteholder**") of its outstanding Notes outlined below (together, the "**Notes**") to tender any and all of their Notes for purchase by the Issuer for cash (the "**Tender Offer**"). The Issuer has appointed Arctic Securities AS, filial Sverige ("**Arctic**") to act as settlement agent (the "**Settlement Agent**") in connection with the Tender Offer.

The Tender Offer is made on the terms and subject to the conditions set out below. Terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning as set forth in the terms and conditions for the Notes (as amended and/or restated from time to time).

#### Purchase price

Subject to the terms and conditions set out in this tender information document and the applicable minimum denomination in respect of the Notes, the Issuer offers to purchase the Notes at the purchase price set out below (the "**Purchase Price**"):

There will be no payment in respect of accrued but unpaid interest.

#### Deadline

The Tender Offer expires on 11 June 2025, unless extended, re-opened, withdrawn or terminated at the sole discretion of the Issuer (the "**Expiration Date**"). The Issuer will announce, the results and whether any Notes will be accepted under the Tender Offer as soon as reasonably practicable after the Expiration Date. Settlement of the Tender Offer is expected to occur approximately ten business days after the Expiration Date (the "**Settlement Date**").

Subject to the terms and conditions set out in this tender information document and applicable law, the Issuer may, in its sole and absolute discretion, extend, re-open, amend or waive any condition of or terminate the Tender Offer at any time. The Issuer is not under any obligation to accept any tender of Notes for purchase pursuant to the Tender Offer. Any tender of Notes for purchase may be rejected by the Issuer for any reason, and the Issuer is not under any obligation to Noteholders to furnish any reason or justification for refusing to accept a tender of Notes for purchase. Noteholders are advised to read carefully this document for the details of and information on the procedures for participating in the Tender Offer.

#### Purpose of the Tender Offer

The Issuer has had financial difficulties during the last years and have during the last weeks had various discussions with certain Noteholders. The Tender Offer is being made to create financial stability, improve the Issuers balance sheet and to reduce its average interest costs. The Tender Offer is further being made as an alternative route to the invalid acceleration initiated by certain Noteholders (which the Issuer will continue to contest) and as announced by way of a press release by the Issuer on 28 May 2025.

#### The Settlement Agent acting as settlement agent

Settlement of the transactions pursuant to the Tender Offer will occur as a secondary trade via the Settlement Agent. The Settlement Agent is acting solely as settlement agent on behalf of the Issuer, and any trades booked as part of the settlement of the Tender Offer shall be understood as being between the relevant Noteholders and the Issuer, with relevant risks and responsibilities to carry out such settlement being between the Noteholders and the Issuer. Noteholders should note that the Settlement Agent will not be bound to make any payments to Noteholder, and any payments to Noteholders by the Settlement Agent on behalf of the Issuer will be subject to the aggregate amount of all amounts payable by the Issuer having been identified as being received by the Settlement

Agent. The Settlement Agent disclaim any liability whatsoever toward Noteholders in connection with the Tender Offer and any execution of the tender settlement.

**Participation**

Noteholders can only participate in the Tender Offer by submitting a valid tender instruction.
